Reason two: it told you that bikes would be *ridden* here - except in the foyer or on the stairs - and not merely looked at. That's a big deal at a bike show because cycling is completely about the riding. Being able to test ride a new bike matters. Sure, we can talk about components, look at shiny things, read magazines, and they're all nice. But they're just the gravy. They no more satisfy the inner cyclist than a picture of a hot dinner stops your stomach rumbling.

I know this because I've been off the bike for more than three months now through injury. And I'm starving.
